Participation in district graduation ceremonies is a privilege, not a right. Except as may be provided in other Board Policies only those students who have met the graduation requirements of the district and have fulfilled all obligations may participate in the high school graduation ceremonies. Obligations include, but are not limited to, senior check-out, paying of all fines and dues, having resolved all discipline issues including detentions, regular school attendance, and returning all uniforms, books, and equipment.

Students who complete an alternative program to graduation or high school completion are not eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony.

The School District of Athens will have a formal ceremony to be held at the conclusion of each school year to honor those students who have completed their graduation requirements. The Board feels that the graduation is for the students and should be planned and organized according to the wishes of the students with approval of the class advisor and principal.

The date for the graduation ceremony will be the Saturday prior to Memorial Day weekend.

We recognize that extenuating circumstances could occur that may affect the date.
