### THIS WEEK:

#### Phonics:

This week we will be working on short e vowels, singular and plural nouns and antonyms.

#### Spelling:

Spelling words- yes, ten, let, bed, red, get

Sight words - after, draw, pictures, read, was, write

#### Reading:

Our story this week will be Dr. Suess. We will be working on biographies, text and graphic features, and descriptive writing

#### Math:

Your students will be able to order numbers up to 20 and add 1 to number. They will write number sentences for "some, some went away", create problem subtraction situations, and decide if subtraction equations are true. They will be able to count backwards from 10 to 1. They will be able to identify morning, evening, and afternoon. They will be able to measure length using non standard units.
