Tutoring: Tutoring is available for any student in need of extra help. Tutoring is offered after school from 3:00-4:00 PM with a certified teacher from each core content area. Tutoring is open to ALL students in grades 7-12. Student athletes and club members are encouraged to attend tutoring. For those students in athletics or clubs-eligibility is run every Friday at 10:00 AM. Students are asked to check with their coach or club advisor for their updated eligibility.


