

## Title I

Purpose is to ensure that all children have a fair, equal and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education. Funds for materials/supplies and salaries.

## Title Ila

Purpose is to increase student academic achievement by helping improve teacher/admin quality and ensure highly qualified teachers. Funds for professional development.

## Title IV

Purpose is to provide all students access to a well-rounded education, improve academic outcomes by maintaining safe and healthy students and improve the use of technology. Funds for advanced classes, materials/supplies.

## **SRSA**

Purpose is to provide rural LEAs with financial assitance to fund initiatives aimed at improving student achievement. Funds for technology that enhances student learning and access.

## **ESA**

Purpose is to provide funding for programs and services to low income students based on FR lunch rates. Funds for technology, literacy, salaries, materials/supplies, and pay for lunches.

## ESSER/ARP

Purpose is to provide districts with emergency relief funds to address the impact of COVID-19. Funds are used for addressing learning loss, systemic procedures, facilities, and transportation.
