Any Senior recipient will be announced at graduation awards ceremony if received by March 15th. Applications will be accepted until June 1st for individual's looking to continue education.

Scholarship Criteria:

- ✓ Recipient must complete at least 10 hours with the carnival committee each year the scholarship is awarded, prior to receiving funds. (Wednesday Night work night, 4th of July Freedom Feast, Week of Fair)
- ✓ Must be resident of Sherman County.
- ✓ Have High School transcript or GED with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- ✓ Must be attending Accredited College/University.
- ✓ Continue to maintain GPA of 2.0 or higher for each semester

Information:

- Your responsibility to provide a copy of your transcript/grades prior to each semester.
- \$500 per semester for no more than four semesters.
- Checks will be made out to school of choice.
