The room parents assigned to each classroom are the only adults invited back to the classroom for the parties and must sign-in in the main office to receive a volunteer pass.

It is the position of Holly Hills Elementary School that all participating students have Halloween costumes that are appropriate for young children. Children need to wear costumes that align with the dress code in the student handbook. <u>Costumes should not show a bare</u> midriff, have eye holes that prevent full range of vision, have sharp objects, or have objects that can be used as a weapon. Please remember, all costumes must be appropriate for the elementary school setting. Blood or any other gory depictions are not appropriate. Toy guns, knives or other weapons should not be a part of any costume. Costumes should not promote violence in any manner.

Due to the Early Dismissal schedule, **all students** <u>should</u> **arrive to school dressed in their costumes** to allow for the parade to begin on-time. Please make sure that the costumes are comfortable for wearing to and from school as well as safe for climbing on and off the bus or walking home.
