WINCHESTER SCHOOL BOARD JUNE 2, 2022 WINCHESTER SCHOOL LIBRARY

The meeting was called to order at 6:39pm. by Board Chair, L. Hildreth.

MINUTES

As Jacob Blake is a new School Board Member, the minutes will be voted on at the next meeting.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT – V. Carey:

- *Field Day was held today; it was moved from tomorrow as rain is expected. The morning was awesome; there were some kinks in the afternoon, but overall things went well.
- *Reminder tomorrow is the last day of Pre-School; last day of Kindergarten is Monday and Eighth Grade Graduation will be held Tuesday, June 7th at 6:00pm. The last day of school for all other students is Wednesday, June 8th which will be a full day and a celebration will be held that day for the staff. June 9th will be a workshop and last day for the teachers. A number of staff members are participating in Staff Development on June 13th and 14th.

Board members need to sign the Oath of Office as Jacob Blake was appointed as a new Board Member. L. Hildreth will send the document for signatures to L. Picard, J. Hadler and J. Rokes.

BUSINESS MANAGER – T. Taylor:

- *A payment needs to be made from the 2021-2022 fund balance as indicated in the Warrant Article, to the Special Education Expendable Trust in the amount of \$25,000.
- *Signatures are needed on forms to add \$125,000 to the Building Improvement Capital Reserve Fund for the 2022-2023 Warrant Article.
- *The Board received a detailed report of YTD expenditures as of 5/31/22 will discuss at the next meeting.
- L. Hildreth MOVED to approve the Payroll Manifest dated 5/27/22 in the amount of \$228,393.06; SECONDED by: L. Picard, VOTED: 3-0, MOTION PASSED.
- L. Hildreth MOVED to approve the Accounts Payable Manifest dated 6/3/22 in the amount of \$304,011.07; SECONDED by: L. Picard, VOTED: 3-0, MOTION PASSED.
- L. Hildreth MOVED to approve the Accounts Payable Manifest dated 6/3/22 in the amount of \$1,805.29; SECONDED by: L. Picard, VOTED: 3-0, MOTION PASSED.

FACILITIES DIRECTOR – M. Hill:

- *There are several projects M. Hill wants to get done around the school and he is requesting to use uncommitted funds for the projects:
- M. Hill discussed work needed in the parking lot and requested approval from the Board.

After discussion, L. Hildreth MOVED to approve the parking lot project in the amount of \$30,250 with Vermont Road Works; SECONDED by: L. Picard, VOTED: 3-0.

There is a window in the cafeteria and four classroom windows that need to be replaced.

After discussion, L. Hildreth MOVED to approve the five windows in room numbers 115, 119, 122, 123, 124 in the amount of \$25,392; SECONDED by: L. Picard, VOTED: 3-0, MOTION PASSED.

No vote was needed, but M. Hill wanted the Board to know that the walk-in cooler in the Elementary School will be done in the next two weeks.

A hood with a suppression system needs to be installed in the Elementary School kitchen.

After discussion, L. Hildreth MOVED to approve a cooktop hood and suppression system from NKE for \$24,650; SECONDED by: L. Picard, VOTED: 3-0, MOTION PASSED.

M. Hill brought a request to purchase a tractor to the Board. He found one at Gary's Power Equipment for \$15,000; a new one would be \$30,000 more. It can be used for work on the fields, general repair, and includes a loader; can get snow removed quickly. The maintenance cost each year is roughly \$1,000.

L. Hildreth MOVED to approve the purchase of a 2014 Mahindra Tractor in the amount of \$15,000 from Gary's Power Equipment; SECONDED by: L. Picard, VOTED: 3-0, MOTION PASSED.

The total cost of the items approved is \$95,292; everything but the hood will come from the Capital Reserve Fund.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT - K. Dassau:

- *K. Dassau will sign the Out-of-District Coordinator and teaching position contracts. per previous approval of the Board.
- *Congratulations to Val Carey on her new position. A Search Committee will be formed which will include the Superintendent, Assistant Principal, Guidance Counselor, Board Member, WSSA rep. and WTA rep.
