

- Schoology classroom groups have been created for all classes 9-12. All students should be added to their "Class of..." group. Be sure to stay up on those posts. Parents are also welcome and encouraged to join my classroom groups.
- Seniors need to get their college applications in as soon as they are ready. Many of the colleges and universities have their scholarship deadlines at different times, including November 1. Students should check with their colleges of choice to be sure of application and scholarship deadlines. Several students are already accepted to their college of choice.
- Seniors are also reminded that they must contact the guidance office when sending in college applications, if you don't use the 'Common Application', so I can send in a high school transcript and school forms.
- · Students and parents should be starting on their college financial aid forms (FAFSA). The FAFSA website now opens on October 1. Seniors should be aware of this. A FAFSA worksheet has been posted on my schoology senior group.
- · The senior scholarship list has also been posted on the 'Guidance Class of 2021' Schoology page. Seniors should keep up on the scholarships as they come in.
- Freshmen will be visiting Millstream on October 21 to see what programs are available.
- · Millstream will be here on November 11 to give a presentation to all sophomores on their programs.
- · Owens Community College will be here on October 26 to meet with all new Spring semester CCP students to register and schedule classes.

### SEARCH FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

#### **Intensive Awareness Campaign Announced**

The Ohio Department of Education is conducting an Intensive Awareness Campaign in accordance with the requirements of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), the Ohio Revised Code, and the State Board of Education's Rules for the Education of Handicapped Children.

Each public school district, Ohio's 16 special education regional resource centers, and the Ohio Department of Education are trying to identify children with disabilities, birth through age 21, who may be in need of special education services.

For children birth to three, a disability means an established condition known to result in delay, or a documented developmental delay.

For children ages three through five, a disability means that a child has a documented deficit in one or more of the following developmental areas: communication, vision, hearing, motor skills, social emotional/behavior functioning, self-help skills, and/or cognitive skills.

For school-age students, a disability means that a student has been identified as having one or more of the following conditions: autism, deaf-blindness, hearing impairment including deafness, mental retardation (DH), multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, emotional disturbance (SBH), specific learning disability, speech or language impairment, traumatic brain injury, and/or visual impairment including blindness.
