Child Find Notice

It is the responsibility of the Northern Adirondack Central School District to identify any child who is a resident who may have a disability, regardless of the severity of the disability. It is also the responsibility of Northern Adirondack CSD to evaluate those students to determine if they are eligible for special education or related services under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act). The school district provides special education and related services for children 3-21 with intellectual disabilities, orthopedic impairments, other health impairments, autism, traumatic brain injuries, visual impairments, hearing impairments, speech and language impairments, learning disabilities and emotional disturbances.

Parents, relatives, public and private agency employees are asked to help us find any child who may have a disability and need special education and related services. If you are aware of a child who may have special needs please contact your school principal:
