It's a crazy time of year for all involved. Tons of senior activities locally and around the area. Lots of end of the year trips to fun and educational places. Track meets where our students are fiercely competing... you get the idea. Through the midst of all of the chaos take time to appreciate what's all happening because it goes quickly.

This year Clifton-Clyde High School will graduate 14 seniors. This is by far our smallest class in the district, but don't let their small size fool you. They are a great group of students that work very hard to do their best for themselves, their school, and their community. Mrs. Knox hosted the Senior Awards night on Tuesday, May 5. At that night our 14 students were awarded \$28,000 in local scholarships! We can't thank the local communities enough for their support.
