#### Did You Know?

- 1. <u>Attendance</u> Multiple unexcused absences, early dismissals and tardies violate state law and shall be categorized as truancies. Students who are absent without a valid excuse for more than three (3) days in one school year, will be classified as truant. Habitual tardiness or truancy will result in a referral to the School Attendance Review Board (SARB).

- 4. Accelerated Reader (AR) all students at Engvall Elementary participate in AR. The **Accelerated** Reader program is a computerized program that tests **reading** comprehension. Students select books on their **reading** level, read independently, and take an independent comprehension test on the computer. Each book is worth a certain number of points based on its length and **reading** level. Students choose AR books every week in the library. An example of a students reading level would be 3.2, the first number represents the grade level and the second number represents the month. In this example the student would be reading at grade 3 second month of school. If you have any questions about AR please ask your child's teacher during parent conferences.
