Policy BCE: Board Committees

The Tri-Valley School Board may authorize the establishment of school board committees from among its membership when it is determined that a committee process facilitates the mission of the school board. A committee of the board is advisory in nature and has only such authority as specified by the full school board. The school board will receive reports or recommendations from a committee for consideration. The school board, however, retains the right and has the duty to make all final decisions related to such reports or recommendations. The school board reserves the right to limit, create or abolish any standing or ad hoc committee as it deems appropriate.

Board members will be appointed to committees by the board president. The board president and the superintendent will serve as ex-officio members of all committees. Board members appointed to standing committees will serve a one-year term.

The school board hereby appoints the following standing committees:

- 1. Facilities Planning Committee
- 2. Negotiations Committee
- 3. Policy Review Committee
- 4. Calendar Committee
- 5. Teacher of the Year Committee
