Policy BCG: School Attorney

The Board may appoint an attorney at its discretion to advise and represent the district.

It will be the duty of the school attorney to advise the Board and the superintendent on the specific legal problems submitted to him or her. The school attorney will attend meetings upon request and will be sufficiently familiar with Board policies, practices and actions under these policies and requirements of the school code of the state to enable him or her to offer the necessary legal advice.
