1. Benefit Profiles, Inc.

David Jones, CFO, stated that the agreement would move our benefits to an electronic enrollment program which would allow our employees to enroll in their benefit programs online. The electronic enrollment program is free to the district.

2. TFT Memorandum of Understanding

Griff Mills, Superintendent, stated that in order to help with staffing issues the district would like to enter into an agreement with TFT for teachers to help support our virtual 6-12 students. Details have been shared with the Board.

3. TFT Memorandum of Understanding

Griff Mills, Superintendent, stated that in order to help with substitute teacher shortages the district would like to enter into an agreement with TFT for teachers to substitute on their prep or have extra students in their classroom. Details have been shared with the Board.

4. 26M Memorandum of Understanding

Griff Mills, Superintendent, stated that in order to help with the bus driver shortage the district would like to enter into an agreement with 26M to have bus drivers on call in the event they are needed. Details have been shared with the Board.

5. 26M Memorandum of Understanding

Griff Mills, Superintendent, stated that this MOU would give our 26M employees a 2% increase. Details have been shared with the Board.

Amber McNew, Board Secretary, asked if the 2% increase was an off schedule payment for their dedication to the district.

Superintendent Mills responded yes.
