Policy Title: <u>Camera Surveillance Systems</u> Code No. <u>804.4</u>

The Greene County Community School District may use a closed circuit television camera surveillance system at various school sites throughout the District to protect School/District property and assets from theft and vandalism, through deterrence and video documentation, as well as to assist in school administrators' performance of disciplinary investigations. District students, staff, parents, guardians, and visitors should not rely on the system to protect individuals from being victims of violent or property crimes, nor to detect other potentially illegal or undesirable activities which may occur although any information obtained may be used as evidence in such cases.

The closed circuit television camera systems shall not be utilized to monitor areas where persons have a reasonable expectation of privacy.
