COVID Return to School Guidance

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Your child is being sent home because he/she has one or more symptoms of COVID-19. Please read the following in regards to your child's returning to school.

Must have one of the following

- *A negative antigen(rapid) COVID-19 test that can be done at the Wellness Center and many Gallatin County Clinics or clinics in the surrounding counties.
- *A negative State COVID-19 send out test that can be performed at the Gallatin County Wellness Center and many Gallatin County Clinics or clinics and hospitals in the surrounding counties.
- *An alternative diagnosis from your primary medical providers that determined the symptoms are other than those of COVID-19

<u>Or</u>

- *Quarantine at home for 10 days and students may return to school on the 11th day as long as symptoms and/or fever have been resolved for 24 hours.
- *Children returning to school from COVID 19 symptoms must be brought to the nursing office with a negative COVID test along with a clearance note from your primary medical provider to return to school.
- *They are not allowed to ride the bus until both papers have been turned into the nursing office.
- *Siblings may stay at school as long as a rapid COVID-19 is performed and brought to the nursing office by the next school day along with a clearance letter from your medical provider. *If the test and clearance letter is not turned into the nursing office, the ill child and all siblings must be kept home the next school day and any following days until both forms are turned in.
