2021 Advanced Placement Analysis and Benefit



- 28 Subject Area AP Exams were offered in the three high schools in 2021.
- 1226 AP tests were taken by 694 students in May/June 2021.



"All-In" campaign increases equity and access by evaluating student potential for participation in AP and district potential for expanding AP offerings with a focus on including underrepresented students.

Note: Minor variations in the following data are attributed to rounding to whole numbers and exclusion of No Response, More than One Race, Other, Amer. Indian/Alaskan native, and Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander as well as student inconsistency in race/ethnicity reporting to WTSD and College Board. Percentages are useful in identifying trends over time.



AP Test Results for 2021


- Colleges usually grant credit for AP scores of 3, 4, or 5.

- Each score of 3, 4, or 5 replaces one 3-credit class.



AP Preparation for 2021-2022

10 AP Summer Academy courses were offered in August 2021 to provide review of prerequisite material, introductory lessons, study recommendations, and initiation of AP online resources to facilitate preparation for rigorous AP courses in the 2021-2022 school year and increase participation and performance.
