

ENROLLING YOUR STUDENT

2023-2024 Farmington Central CUSD #265 Registration

Kindergarten(that have NOT attended pre-school here) or New Student Registration, you will need the following information:

- Original, certified copy of your child's birth certificate
- Three Proofs of Residency (Please review the "[Establishing Student Residency](#)" link)
- A current Illinois physical, dental, and vision exam (by the first day of school)
- Students entering from out of state need a current Illinois physical and dental and vision exam
- Kindergarten students must be born on or before September 1, 2018 to enroll in Kindergarten

NEW STUDENTS TO THE DISTRICT: If you are moving in to the Farmington Central School District, please follow the "[New Student Online Enrollment Link](#)" to start the enrollment process. RETURNING STUDENTS: If you are a returning student, Enrollment Verification will be available on July 11, 2023, through your Skyward Family Access account. Call the District office at (309) 245-1000 x.4 if you need your log-in information. If you do not have access to the internet, laptop computers are available by appointment with District Office. **This process must be completed before the first day of school or the student cannot attend.**

We are asking all families to fill out the free and reduced forms for the new school year. Starting on July 1, 2023, families will need to fill out the **Free/Reduced Household Application** for the **2023-2024** school year, if you have any questions, you can either email Laken Slack at lslack@dist265.com or call 245-1000 ext. 5.

HEALTH INFORMATION

If your student is enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time, please review the "[Health Exam Requirements by Grade](#)" link. They must have a physical conducted by an Illinois physician within 30 days of enrollment. If your student is transferring from an Illinois school, we will request all health records from their previous school.
