Dear Richfield Jr/Sr High Students and Families,

Regional Summer School will be held at Gregory B. Jarvis Middle School in Mohawk, NY. Registration will begin at noon on June 21st, which is when all Q4 and Final grades will be unlocked and visible in SchoolTool. (Regents grades will be posted later in some cases. See sign up information for those exams on page 2.) Students should register for Regional Summer School by Monday, June 26th at 3pm to ensure placement despite the BOCES deadline of noon on June 28th. *Summer School will begin on July 10th and run every Monday thru Thursday until August 15th*. Students can not miss more than one full day and are removed from the program after their second full day missed. More details on attendance are included in the packet. All students will receive an email with the information contained in this letter. Attached to the email will be the documents noted below. A link to register for summer school via a Google Form will be included, which will serve as parent permission. Some general guidelines for registration are noted below, but feel free to contact the School Counseling Office with any questions that arise once grades are finalized in SchoolTool.

- Summer School Transportation: Students must ride the RSCS bus to and from Summer School. Parental written permission must be handed in to the BOCES Regional Summer School staff for special exceptions. Families must arrange for the student to be in the school parking lot by 6:25 on the first day of Summer School. The bus will leave promptly at 6:35am. On all other days the bus will leave promptly at 6:50.

Students should register for summer school in the order noted below for...

Grades 7-8

- Any student who failed 8th grade Spanish, must register as this is a High School graduation requirement.
- Any student who failed three of the four core classes being English, Science, Social Studies and Math will sign up for the Middle Level Academy.
- Any student who refuses to follow these guidelines will face possible retention by the Retention Committee.

Students should register for regional summer school in the order noted below for...

Grades 9-12

- Any failed core course (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies) must be taken in summer school.
- Only two classes can be taken in summer school. Students should sign up for summer school coursework in the following priority order...
 - o Priorities 1+2: English and Global
 - o Priority 3: 9th Graders Living Environment / 10th Graders Regents Algebra
 - o Priority 4: 9th Graders Basic Algebra / 10th Graders Earth Science
 - 10th graders who fail AFNR: this course is not available in Summer School and another elective will have to be taken in the future.
- Students who refuse to make up failed classes that can be done in regional summer school will be required to retake the course(s) the following year. This may prevent moving onto Sophomore, Junior or Senior status. For instance, students who don't have Junior status can not attend Career Technical Education coursework at BOCES. Students who failed over two courses will be provided credit recovery opportunities the following school year if they pass the two summer school courses they enroll in.

REGENTS FAILURE

Regents grades will be entered by June 27th in all likelihood. Please check SchoolTool and register for Regents Review by Thursday, June 29. This gives RSCS time to confirm your registration by the July 6 Regional Summer School deadline. Students will also be emailed a reminder for any exams we recommend they retake.
