

TARGETED SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN SUMMARY 21-22

PRIORITY #1

Columbia High School will improve average daily attendance rate

MEASURABLE GOAL

By June 2022, Columbia High School will improve its average daily attendance rate to 95%

ACTION STEPS

- Teachers will emphasize the importance of attendance.
- Monitor consecutive absences to ensure accurate active enrollment.
- Teachers will contact home when students miss two consecutive days of school.
- Pull weekly attendance reports. Check communication logs to ensure parents have been contacted.
- Recognize students with perfect and improved attendance.

PRIORITY #2

Columbia High School will increase the 4-year cohort graduation rate.

MEASURABLE GOAL

By June 2022, Columbia High School will increase its graduation rate to 78.3%-(baseline 19-20 SY-73.3%)

ACTION STEPS

- Identify students who are not on track for promotion with their cohort utilizing the graduation planner in PowerSchool and reviewing earned credits and current grades.
- Assign mentors to at risk seniors.
- Mentors will meet weekly and document contact/progress in communication log.
- CARES* team meets weekly to review/track progress of at risk students and make plans for further interventions as needed.
- Create individualized graduation plan and communicate to family.
- Check in with students at end of each quarter to review progress on plan. Update family on progress towards graduation.
- Revise graduation plan as needed (reschedule/remediate classes as needed).
