- ASB Report – Rollie Marshall
 - Boys and Girls basketball teams both qualified for the district tournament going in as 2nd place. At the tournament, boys won both games and girls lost both games. Boys will now host a State playoff game this Saturday. Rollie also announced the student/athletes that received all-league recognition.
- Student of the Month – Rollie Marshall

- Elementary – Principal Rollie introduced Samantha Lamb as the elementary student of the month. Rollie shared some thoughts from the staff about Samantha: she is always eager to learn, can't wait to tackle challenges, a joy to have in class, kind to classmates, respectful to staff, and always has a smile on her face. She is a very driven student and wonderful example of what it means to be a leader. She's an all-around great student and always works hard to do her best work.

- Ione/Arlington Sports Co-op Update

Rollie shared that Arlington would like to continue the co-op with Ione for football and volleyball. He has talked with several athletes and coaches and almost all are for it. Rollie asked JJ to send out a survey to the fall athletes from the different sports. There are some folks in the community that don't want the co-op. Generally, 85-90% were in favor of continuing. Bonding between the student athletes of both schools has been amazing. Rollie asked JJ to re-send the survey out to students and parents. He will share the results prior to the March board meeting. All coaches have given the thumbs up.

➤ Superintendent Report – Jon Peterson

- GOBHI Proposal

There is a free program offered by GOBHI – they will send three of their staff members that are health education specialists to work with 6th-12th graders on a drug awareness initiative. They have an all-day option, half-day option or just an assembly option. Rollie will survey staff on their thoughts.

- State Update

Everything happening at the State level is tied to the Student Success Act.
