AWARDS, RECOGNITION AND CORRESPONDENCE

- ASB Report – Principal Rollie Marshall shared the latest ASB report:
 - Currently planning for a Sadie's dance in February - talking about a theme and activities.
 - Planning a blood drive and community clean-up day this Spring
- Student of the Month
 - Elementary – Principal Rollie Marshall introduced Jose Toy as the Elementary Student of the Month. Rollie shared letters from the staff with the following comments about Jose: Pleasure to teach, wonderful student and joy to have in class, always has a smile and is willing to help out, has a positive attitude and work ethic. His enthusiasm for learning is allowing him to excel. Rollie presented him with an Ione pen and certificate.

- Secondary – Gary Walls was selected by the staff as the Secondary Student of the Month. Principal Rollie Marshall shared thoughts from teachers and staff: Outstanding student and leader, maturity level far exceeds his classmates, skilled ability to adapt to any situation, fantastic worker, reliable and works quickly and efficiently. - School Board Appreciation –
 - January is School Board Appreciation month so Jon shared a proclamation from the Governor and also presented them with goody bags from the District.
 - Students representing the student body and staff gave the board members and administration metal cardinal signs made by the shop class.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

- Bridg-It Program
 - Ione students, Jr. Roque, Amelia Baker and Katelyn Thompson shared information on the Bridg-It program. The C.O.O of Bridg-It, Ian, joined by teleconference. The students explained the program is to focus on positivity and encouragement amongst the student body. Daily encouragement quotes are shared each day in the announcements and thousands of positive “shout-outs” have been documented. Ione is ranked 2nd in the US with the most shout-outs. There are Monthly activities and challenges to boost leadership and encouragement. The program is helping kids learn how to develop leadership skills. The official slogan is “Keep it classy Ione”.

REPORTS

- Audit Report – Kylie McClintock
 - Kylie handed out copies of the 2018-19 audit report to the Board and administration. She noted it was a very clean audit.
- Enrollment Report – Jon Peterson
 - Jon noted we are down five students from last month for a total of 176. Rollie explained we had six students withdraw – three to Mexico and three to Condon and we gained one to come up with the difference of 5.
- Principal Report – Rollie Marshall
 - SRO Update
 - Due to the deployment of Deputy Kipley, our new SRO is Ryan Jundt who started two weeks ago. Rollie noted he is very kid oriented and personable. Great addition to Ione.
 - Vape Update
 - The vape machines in bathrooms and locker rooms are up and running. This Thursday, January 30 a five-week intervention class is starting to help with addiction.
 - ESL Field Trip
 - An ESL three-day field trip is planned using funds from the HB3499 grant. Twenty students will be attending and will be visiting the Newport Aquarium and OMSI.
- Superintendent Report – Jon Peterson
 - Property Acquisition Discussion

There are five lots located on the east side of the track that could potentially be used to expand the track at a later date. Rob Crum owns one lot and one of the other owners would like to donate theirs to the school district. This will be discussed at February's work session.
 - State Update
 - The official graduation rates from 2018-19 were released last week from the State and the Ione grad rate was #1 with 100%. Awesome news!!

BE IT RESOLVED, upon motion by Stacie Ekstrom and seconded by Lisa Rietmann, which was unanimously approved, that the 2018-19 Ione School District's Annual Assurance Report assures compliance with Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 581, Division 22, as to the Standards for Public Elementary and Secondary Schools.

- Graduation Date Change Request
 - Due to the date of the OSAA State track meet, there could potentially be a conflict for some seniors being able to attend graduation. Some senior parents requested to move graduation from May 29th to May 30th at the same time of 7:00 pm to ensure all seniors can attend.

BE IT RESOLVED, upon motion by Lisa Rietmann and seconded by Stacie Ekstrom, which was unanimously approved, that the Ione School Board approves the request to change the 2020 graduation date from May 29th to May 30th.
