BE IT RESOLVED, upon motion by Stacie Ekstrom and seconded by Ed Rietmann, which was unanimously approved, that ad valorem property taxes are hereby imposed upon the assessed value of all taxable property within the district for tax year 2020-2021 at the rate of \$4.0342 per \$1,000 of assessed value for permanent rate tax, and in the account of \$231,000 for debt service on general obligation bonds.
