1. Your **senior picture** must follow the following specifications:
 - Portrait style pose, including head and shoulders only
 - Students may **not** wear:
 - See-through clothing and/or shirts that expose midriffs
 - Clothing with profane or obscene words or gestures
 - Clothing that advertises alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, sexually explicit terms, or ethnic derogation
 - Digital photos must be at least 300 DPI in JPEG format
 - If you email your photo, please send to yearbook@pembrokecsd.org.
 - The yearbook advisers and staff are not responsible for images sent to any email address other than yearbook@pembrokecsd.org
 - Please make sure your photographer sends the image to the correct email address and has confirmation that the image was received.
2. Your **baby picture** must also follow the following specifications:
 - Digital photos must be at least 300 DPI in JPEG format
 - If you email your photo, please send to yearbook@pembrokecsd.org
 - *The yearbook advisers and staff are not responsible for images sent to any email address other than yearbook@pembrokecsd.org.*

We do NOT accept hard copies of baby pictures or senior pictures. Please scan all pictures and email them to yearbook@pembrokecsd.org

3. Your **senior quote** should be in the following format:
 - Mr. Tripp will send you an e-mail with a link to Google Forms. Please follow the specifications provided. **Quotes will only be accepted through the Google Form provided.**
 - “Quote – to speak or write (a passage) from another with credit acknowledgment.” -Webster’s Dictionary
 - The quote may **not** contain: profanity, sexual references, drug/alcohol references or weapon/violence references

The yearbook staff and school administration have the right to choose a different picture and/or quote if it does not meet the above guidelines/specifications.

Please take into consideration that ALL students, faculty and staff at Pembroke will be seeing these photos and reading your quotations – please be responsible and mindful of your audience.
