Who: Reading Teachers and professionals who support Reading


When: June 1 & 2, August 9-11, and Fall of 2021 (late hires)

- Emphasize on phonemic awareness and phonics instruction
- Integrates Spelling, Handwriting, and Writing
- Systemic and scripted approach to teaching reading



Small Group Instruction / Workshop Model






Blended Learning Models

Station-Rotation	 Collaborative Relevant to current content Teacher led stations Same schedule
Class/Lab-Rotation	 Students rotate to different classes or a lab Individualized based on student need Portion of lesson can be on Canvas
Flipped-Classroom	 Students spend time away from school learning content Time in class is spent with teacher reinforcing learning concepts Easily individualized
Individual-Rotation	 Student with specific academic needs has individual schedule that he/she rotates through Provides personalized learning opportunities For intervention or acceleration


