Class of 2018 – 19.9%

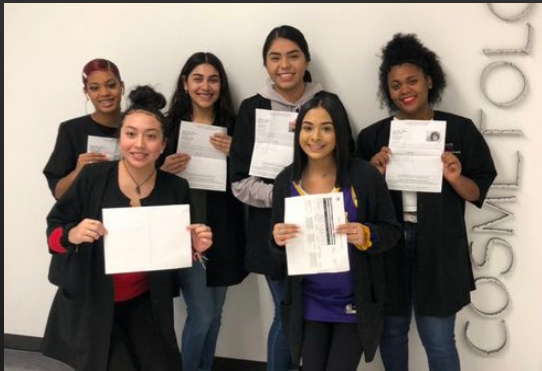
Class of 2019 – 21.3%
