- No CVAP data in the files
- New Group Quarters Table in the files
- Differential Privacy Cases

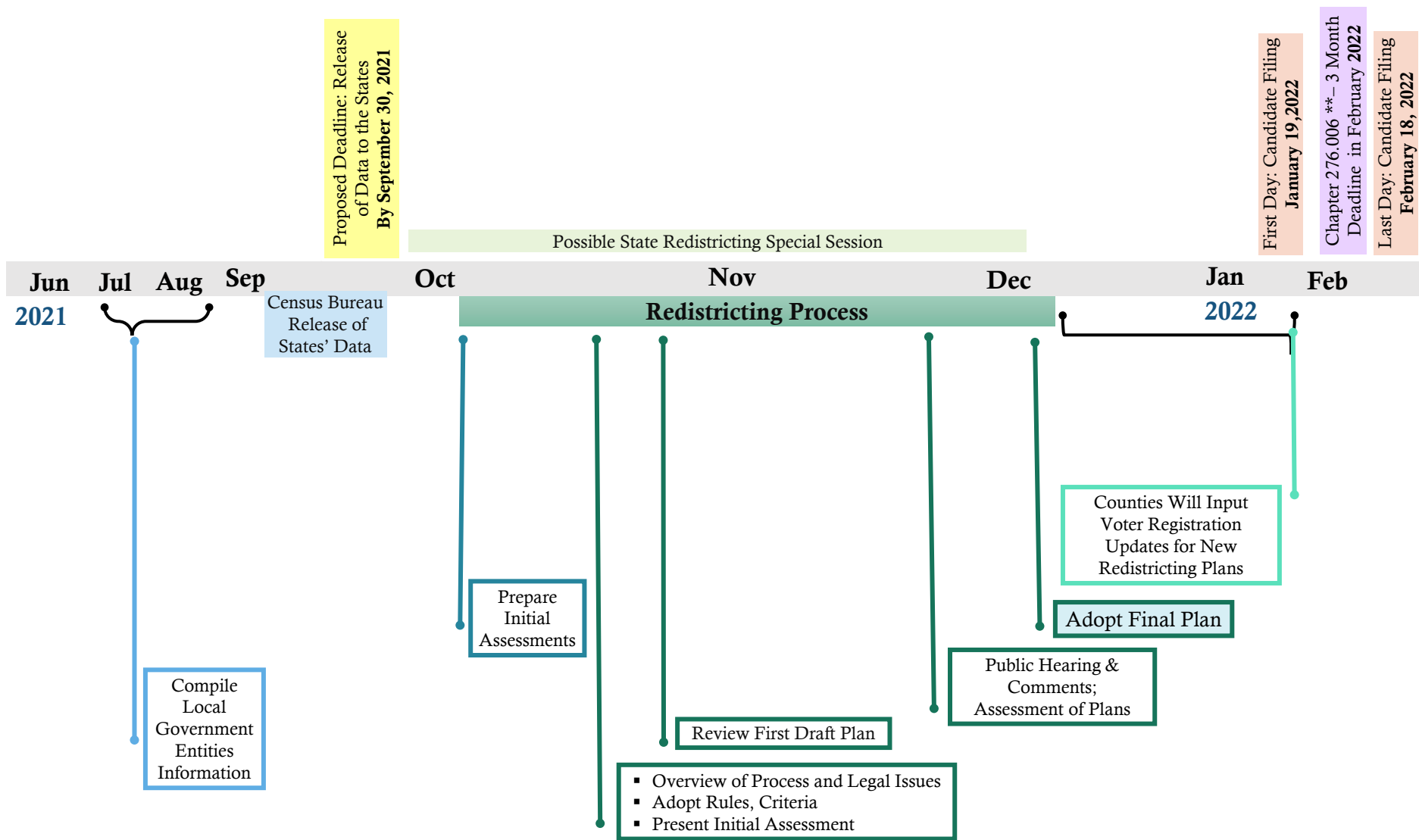
IMPACT OF DELAY

- Impact on May '22 General Elections of other political subdivisions
- Tyler ISD has a May 2022 General Election
- Single Member Districts 1, 3, and 6
- Candidate filing for May 2022 election begins January 19th

IMPACT OF DELAY

- Impacts to other local government entities:
 - Primary schedule drives county redistricting.
(mid-Nov candidate filing)
 - Compressed redistricting timeline

Proposed 2021 Redistricting Time Line for an Entity with a May 7, 2022 Election Based on Census Bureau Release of Data by September 30, 2021*



*Based upon the last information posted by the Census Bureau on February 12, 2021.

**NOTE: Texas Election Code Chapter 276.006:

A change in the boundary of a political subdivisions other than a county must be adopted 3 months prior to the election under than plan.
