Emergency Bad Weather e-Learning Day Plan

- **Mannheim School District 83 has adopted this e-Learning plan in lieu of making up school days at the end of the school year.**
- At times during the school year, weather conditions may necessitate the closing of school due to hazardous conditions for children and staff.
- A decision may be made to have an **Emergency Bad Weather** e-Learning day.
- When such conditions occur, announcements are made over radio stations affiliated with the Computerized Storm Information System and the district website, www.d83.org.
- The district will also use a notification system to broadcast important announcements by phone, text, and email.
- Students are expected to bring their 1:1 device home at the end of each school day, so that they will always be prepared if an **Emergency Bad Weather** e-Learning day is announced.
- The plan has been approved by the District 83 Board of Education, West 40 Intermediate Service Center, and Illinois State Board of Education.
