#### Hello Fall River Community,

The budget had its final approval by the school board on October 27th. Even though the district is getting less state financial aid, we have been able to lower our tax levy by over \$50,000. That, with a 5% increase in equalized property values in the district will lower our tax mill rate from \$7.90 to \$7.32, a property tax decrease of \$58 on a property valued at \$100,000.

Better enrollment and open enrollment numbers have been a big help to our budget. We have 493 students attending school in Fall River this year, more than we had in any of the past seven years. Also the imbalance of students leaving the district compared to the number of students coming into our district has been turning around over the past three years. The number of students open enrolled out of the district compared to students open enrolled into the district was a negative 64. That difference is now only 19, a gain of 45 more students choosing our district compared to other local districts.

The school board received a summary of state testing results at its October meeting. You can be proud of your students and our teachers and support staff who are helping our students succeed. In 22 out of 27 grade and subjects they scored much above the state average. Looking at the totals of all overall testing results, our students are at the top compared to area schools.

Stop by the Prairie Street athletic complex. You will see the youth ball fields at Prairie Street are now ready for play next spring. The grass is coming in nicely for a first year. Normally it takes three years to get fields up to peak condition. Thanks to all those who have made it possible for our students to have such great facilities. The garage is almost done, just in time to store a lot of equipment over the winter.
