COMPLAINTS UNDER TITLE IX AT WOODVILLE ISD

Complaints must be submitted in writing not more than 300 days after the incident(s) in question. For good cause and at the Schools discretion, the writing requirement or the 300 day time limitation may be waived.

If you are a student who believes you have been or are the victim of sexual harassment, including sexual assault, sexual violence or other sexual misconduct, by another School student, you may report such conduct or file a complaint under Title IX with the Title IX Coordinator.

Employees: If you are an employee who believes you have been subjected to discrimination under Title IX, including sexual harassment, or who wishes to file a complaint under Title IX, you can do so with the Title IX Coordinator in the Office of Staff Support Services. Complaints must be submitted in writing not more than 300 days after the incident(s) in question. For good cause and at the Schools discretion, the writing requirement or the 300 day time limitation may be waived.

Federal and state laws prohibit the taking of retaliatory measures against any individual who files a complaint in good faith.
