Subject: Revision to 2021-2022 School Calendar

The Harrison County Board of Education met October 26th and passed a motion to revise the 2021-2022 Harrison County School Calendar. That revision makes November 22nd and November 23rd non-instructional days (no school) for students. This means that now there is no school for students November 22nd through November 26th; the week of Thanksgiving.

However, November 22^{nd} and 23rd will be work days for staff. Personnel will report to their schools or work locations. The calendar currently reflects a Thanksgiving Break for all on November $24^{th} - 26^{th}$ and recognizes November 25^{th} as the Thanksgiving holiday.

The pandemic interrupted student learning last year, and staff members have been working tirelessly on Individual Learning Plans for their students. The two work days in November will allow teachers to collaborate and focus their efforts in meeting the instructional needs of their students.
