**Definitions:**

*Quarantine:* The individual has been in close contact with someone that has tested positive for COVID-19. They will be in quarantine for 10-14 days depending on development of symptoms and will be released to return to school or work on the date determined by the Tazewell County Health Department.

*Isolation:* The individual is experiencing COVID-like symptoms as listed in the COVID-19 Interim Exclusion Guidance. They will remain isolated at home until they have met specific criteria as determined by IDPH guidelines. This may include siblings in the home.

*COVID-19 Positive:* The individual has tested positive for COVID-19 and is under quarantine at home for a minimum of 10 days. They will be released to return to school or work on the date determined by the Tazewell County Health Department.
