- Operating Millage Supports the General Fund Expenses and Annual School Budget
- Voter Approved Sinking Fund .99 mil approved by voters in 2017 generates, approximately \$500,000 used annually for instructional technology, safety & facility maintenance
- Voter Approved Bond Could be used for capital projects and high priced maintenance needs




MCC Debt Pay Off

(Assumes taxable value growth of 2.00% - 2.00%)








District Millage Comparison
