NO Student Parking is permitted in Green Dot Spaces







Several financial aid specialists will be on campus to assist parents/guardians as you complete the FAFSA online. The FAFSA will be completed using your 2020 tax documents.

Please bring your Chromebook.

The state of Illinois has made FAFSA completion a graduation requirement of the class of 2022.

Each senior student must compete either the FAFSA or

the <u>FAFSA non participation form</u> (return form to the PCHS Counseling Office).

You and your student will **EACH** need to create an **FSA ID**. This can be completed at https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm. Your student SHOULD NOT use your email address or his/her Pekin High email address to create his/her ID as he/she will not have access to it after graduation. Each **FSA ID** must use a unique email address. Make sure to write this information down in a safe place.


