

## WELCOME TO THE LOUISIANA STUDENTS OF THE YEAR AWARDS PROGRAM!

This packet consolidates the most important information for student applicants. Please read all of the information in this document and review the [LDOE 2021-2022 Students of the Year Selection Guidelines](#).

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## OVERVIEW

The Louisiana Students of the Year Program has been recognizing outstanding students across the state for over 25 years. At the annual Louisiana State Students of the Year Awards Ceremony, the State Selection Committee recognizes the finalists from every region and names the new Louisiana Elementary, Middle and High School Student of the Year.

Louisiana public and approved nonpublic schools with grades 5, 8 and/or 12 may participate. Eligible students must be enrolled in grades 5, 8 or 12 with a minimum 3.1 cumulative grade point average for the prior three years and the first semester of the current academic year.

- STEP 1** Participating schools nominate one eligible student in each category.
- STEP 2** Student nominees prepare their application portfolios.
- STEP 3** Schools submit application portfolios to the School System-Level Selection Committee.
- STEP 4** School System-Level Selection Committees advance one nominee per grade level.
- STEP 5** Regional Selection Committees advance one nominee per grade level.
- STEP 6** State Selection Committee announces a Louisiana Student of the Year in each category.

Participating school systems create **written** selection guidelines and implement processes uniformly across schools and grade levels. These guidelines should include procedures for resolving issues and disputes related to candidate selection. Students and families should understand these processes **before** schools nominate students to the School System Level Committee.

Regional and state finalists participate in an interview process, which could be in-person or online (as conditions permit). As such, schools and school systems are strongly encouraged to incorporate student interviews into their selection processes.

## PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS

Using the Appendices B and C in the Student of the Year Guidelines, students will submit the following for school system consideration:

1. The **student data application/release** form is signed by the parent.
2. Attach a photocopy of the academic and attendance record, report cards and/or high school transcripts reflecting academic performance in previous years—including the first semester grades of the current grade level; scores for all **required statewide or nonpublic school annual assessments** taken prior to the current school year; scores for any regional and national tests (AP, CLEP, ACT, PSAT, SAT, IBCs); TOPS-aligned dual enrollment coursework; TOPS/TOPS Tech eligibility status; work-based experience documentation; associate degree coursework/status; other pertinent artifacts that document academic and CTE accomplishments. If scores are not available, please indicate the reason.
3. Include a typed or handwritten autobiographical **sketch** that includes family history, interests, career aspirations, etc. The students should be encouraged to address at least three or more issues that are important to them and that have had an influence on their lives.
4. The **application form** that includes evidence of the student's leadership ability, participation in activities, honors, awards, citizenship and service involvement.
5. A **current school photograph** or similar kind of print is incorporated. Regional and state finalists will need to submit an electronic photo as part of their application.

## PROGRAM TIMELINE

<b>October 15, 2021</b>	School systems, CMOs, and dioceses submit names of local and regional chairpersons to the LDOE or the diocesan office by this date.
<b>November 10, 2021</b>	LDOE sends the names of the zone and regional chairpersons to the school system and CMO coordinators by this date.
<b>November–December</b>	Schools select nominees and submit names to the School System-Level Selection Committees.
<b>December 10, 2021</b>	Each CMO selects and submits one nomination per grade level to the Charter Zone Selection Committee coordinators.
<b>January 3-7, 2021</b>	CMO Zone Committees select nominees.
<b>January 19, 2022</b>	School System-Level Selection Committees submit nomination forms to the Regional Student Selection Committee chairperson by this date.
<b>January 24-February 25, 2022</b>	Regional Selection Committees review application portfolios, interview nominees and score new regional writing samples.
<b>March 2, 2022</b>	Regional chairpersons electronically submit nomination forms and portfolios to the state program coordinator by this date.
<b>March 4, 2022</b>	LDOE releases the names of the twenty-one regional nominees.
<b>March 14-April 13, 2022</b>	State Selection Committee reviews application portfolios, conducts interviews and scores new state writing samples.
<b>April 13, 2022</b>	State Selection Committee names the Elementary, Middle/Junior High, and High School Students of the Year.
