Lookeba-Sickles Board of Education September 22, 2021, 7:00 p.m. High School Cafeteria

The Lookeba-Sickles Board of Education met in regular session to conduct business for the month of September.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Mr. House. Members present were Tommy House, Justin Harvey, Sarah Farr, and Jami Radacy. Also in attendance were Shirley Gathers, Shana Lierle, Mike Davis, and Steve Parker with Alcohol and Drug Testing, Inc. Frank Klassen was absent. Mike Davis gave the invocation at this time.

Mr. Harvey made a motion to approve 2021-2022 General Fund encumbrances #79 thru #138 and #50035. 2021-2022 General Fund warrants #149 thru #261. 2021-2022 Building Fund warrants #16 thru #17. 2021-2022 Building Fund warrants #12 thru #20. 2021-2022 Child Nutrition Fund encumbrances #2 thru #15 and #50000. 2021-2022 Child Nutrition Fund warrants #2 thru #14, that were reviewed and discussed. Mr. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Ms. Radacy, Mr. House, Mrs. Farr, and Mr. Harvey. Motion Passed

At this time the board welcomed Steve Parker with Alcohol & Drug Testing, Inc.

Mrs. Gathers and Mr. Davis presented their principal's reports.

Superintendent's Report:

Mr. Davis informed the board of the filing dates for the 2022 School Board Election, which is December 7-9, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

At this time Steve, with Alcohol & Drug Testing, Inc., discussed the possibility of the implementation of a student random drug testing program, for students enrolled in 7th thru 12th grades here at Lookeba-Sickles.

Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve the implantation of this random drug testing program for high school students of Lookeba-Sickles. Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Mr. House, Ms. Radacy, and Mrs. Farr. Motion Approved

Mr. Harvey made a motion to approve the 2021-2022 Estimate of Needs and Publication Sheet. Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Mrs. Farr, Mr. House, and Ms. Radacy. Motion Carried

Lookeba-Sickles - education in action!

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Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve the Statutory Waiver 70 O.S. § 3-126 to allow for a SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPOWERMENT WAIVER for our Library/Media Centers. Mr. Harvey seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Mr. House, Mrs. Farr, and Ms. Radacy. Motion Approved

Mr. Davis presented the 2021-2022 school budget broken down by function codes to the board for discussion, questions, and input. The board considered the information and Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve this budget. Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Mrs. Farr, Ms. Radacy, and Mr. House. Motion Passed

Mr. Harvey made a motion to enter executive session at 8:28 p.m. to review and discuss “non-certified” contracts for the 2021-2022 term. Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Mr. House, Ms. Radacy, and Mrs. Farr. Motion Carried

Mr. Harvey made a motion to return to open session at 8:33 p.m., with Ms. Radacy seconding this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Ms. Radacy, Mr. House, and Mrs. Farr. Motion Approved

Mrs. Farr stated that only the items listed on the agenda were discussed during executive session.



Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve allowing the superintendent and principals to have the local authority to implement a mask mandate if conditions warrant such an action due to the ever changing Covid-19 situation, in order to help protect the health of our student population. Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Klassen, Mr. House, Ms. Radacy, and Mrs. Farr. Motion Carried
