## Lookeba-Sickles Board of Education August 25, 2021, 7:00 p.m. High School Library

The Lookeba-Sickles Board of Education met in a regular board meeting to conduct business for the month of August.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Mr. House. Members present were Tommy House, Jami Radacy, Frank Klassen, Sarah Farr, and Justin Harvey. Also in attendance were Shirley Gathers, Mike Davis, and Shana Lierle. At this time Mr. Davis gave the invocation.

Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, which included 2021-2022 General Fund Encumbrances #32 thru #78 and #50031 thru #50034. 2021-2022 General Fund Warrants #50 thru #148. 2021-2022 Building Fund Encumbrances #3 thru #15. 2021-2022 Building Fund Warrants #3 thru #11. 2021-2022 Child Nutrition Fund Encumbrance #1. 2021-2022 Child Nutrition Fund Warrant #1. 2021-2022 Transportation Bond of 2021 Encumbrance #1. 2021-2022 Transportation Bond of 2021 Warrant #1, that were reviewed and discussed. Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Ms. Radacy, Mr. Harvey, Mr. House, Mrs. Farr, and Mr. Klassen. Motion Passed

Mrs. Gathers and Mr. Davis gave their principal's reports to the board.

### Superintendent's Report:

At this time Mr. Davis informed the board of final transfer numbers, of the upcoming OSSBA workshop, and updated the board on the transportation bond.

Mr. Harvey made a motion to approve the 2021-2022 bona-fide loan agreement which allows the cooks to be paid out of the general fund. This motion was seconded by Mr. Klassen. Voting yes, Mr. Klassen, Mr. House, Mr. Harvey, Mrs. Farr, and Ms. Radacy. Motion Approved

Mrs. Farr made a motion to approve selected staff and volunteers to serve on the following 2021-2022 Staff Development, Curriculum, Discipline, Gifted & Talented, Safe School, and Healthy and Fit school committees. Ms. Radacy seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mrs. Farr, Ms. Radacy, Mr. House, Mr. Klassen, and Mr. Harvey. Motion Carried

Mr. Klassen made a motion to enter into executive session at 7:38 p.m. to discuss the following items: resignation letter from a non-certified staff member, certified contracts and/or extra duty contracts, and remaining non-certified contracts. Ms. Radacy seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Klassen, Mr. House, Mr. Harvey, Mrs. Farr, and Ms. Radacy. Motion Passed

Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve the availability of eligible Lookeba-Sickles High School students to take math and/or science classes for graduation credit at Caddo-Kiowa Technology Center for the 2021-2022 school year, Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Mr. Klassen, Mr. House, Mrs. Farr, and Ms. Radacy. Motion Passed

Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve the request from Mr. and Mrs. Chad Cooper for their daughter to attend the Lookeba-Sickles School FFA class 1 hour a day, in person, to remain eligible for participation in the FFA program of Oklahoma. Mr. Klassen seconded this motion. Voting yes, Ms. Radacy, Mr. Klassen, Mr. House, Mr. Harvey, and Mrs. Farr. Motion Approved

September 22, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., was confirmed as the next regular scheduled board meeting.

Ms. Radacy made a motion to approve the days to hours schedule for the 2021-2022 school year. Mrs. Farr seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mr. Harvey, Mr. House, Mrs. Farr, Mr. Klassen, and Ms. Radacy. Motion Approved


It was requested that Board President, Tommy House, sign the "Days to Hours," letter for the OSDE.


