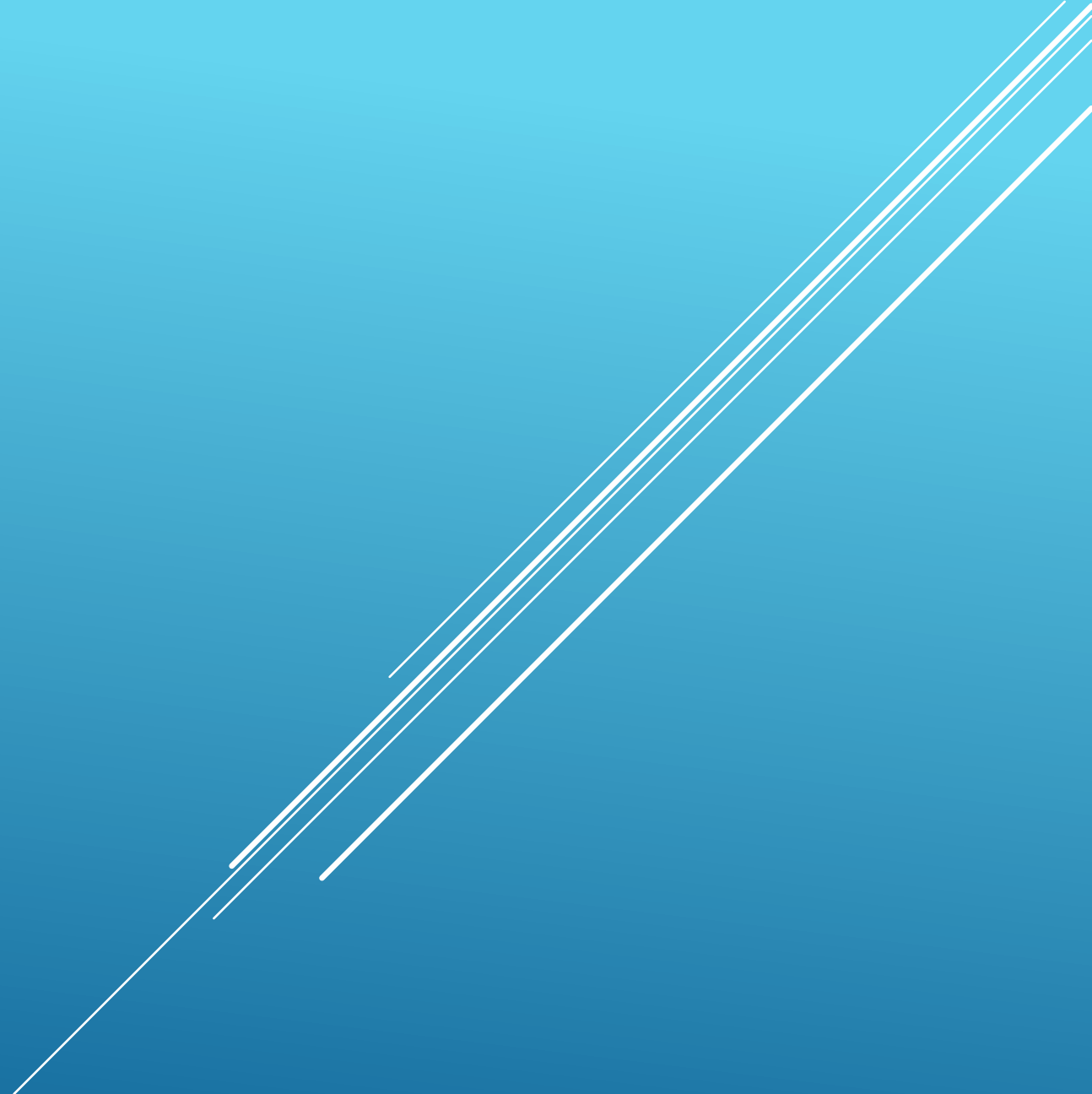

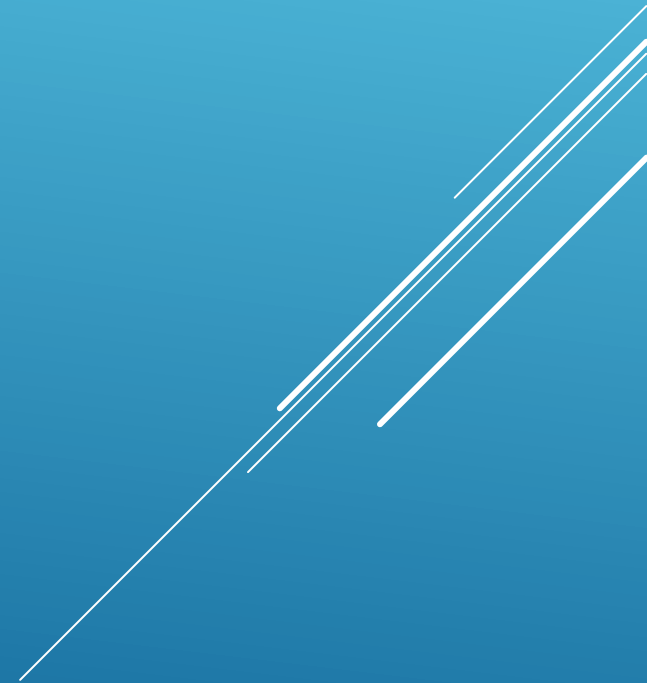

- ✓ September 7, 2021
- ✓ Geneseo will be open 5 days for in-person learning.
- ✓ Grades K-12
- ✓ Universal Masking will be required by all while indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
- ✓ Students will be seated 3 feet apart when practicable.

IN-PERSON LEARNING

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- ✓ Available only if the student has a documented medical condition.
- ✓ Remote learning for these few students will be offered by an outside provider, GV BOCES or other provider.
- ✓ Please contact your child's building principal for further information.

REMOTE INSTRUCTION

- ✓ Masks must be worn on school transportation.
- ✓ School Transportation can resume at full capacity.
- ✓ Transportation forms from parents indicate 75% of students will school transportation.
- ✓ Buses will unload in the front of the school bus loop.
- ✓ Please use the drop off loop for drop and pickup of your child(ren).

TRANSPORTATION

- ✓ Meals will be served in the cafeteria.
- ✓ Students will be seated in desks.
- ✓ Students will be spaced 5 feet apart when practicable.

BREAKFAST AND LUNCHESES

- ✓ Parents are responsible for screening their child(ren) for symptoms of COVID-19 prior to boarding district transportation or entering the District facilities.
- ✓ Employees and visitors are responsible for monitoring themselves prior to entering
- ✓ Visitors will be limited and must have scheduled appointments to enter the District facilities.

SCREENING

- ✓ Fall Sports will move forward as planned.
- ✓ Extracurriculars will start in September.
