

WHAT IS LEARNED IN 4K?

SOCIAL SKILL GOALS BY THE END OF THE 4K YEAR:

- Respects safety of self and others.
- Plays cooperatively with others.
- Participates in group activities.
- Uses social skills appropriate to the situation.
- Shares materials and equipment.
- Clearly expresses personal needs, wants, and ideas.
- Expresses feelings with words.

ACADEMIC LEARNING GOALS BY THE END OF THE 4K YEAR:

- Recognizes own name.
- Recites the alphabet.
- Names uppercase letters.
- Prints first name.
- Names colors red, yellow, blue, green, orange, purple, black, brown, white and pink.
- Recognizes rhyming words.
- Produces the beginning sound of an object.
- Answers who, what, where and why questions from a story.
- Predicts what might happen next in a story.
- Names circle, square, rectangle and triangle.
- Counts to 20.
- Names the digits 0 to 10 in print.
- Sorts objects by color.
- Recreates simple patterns.
- Focuses on teacher-directed activities for 10-15 minutes.

PHYSICAL SKILL GOALS BY THE END OF THE 4K YEAR:

- Puts coat, hat, and mittens on and off by self.
- Independently zips own coat.
- Holds a pencil with acceptable handwriting grip.
- Holds a scissors correctly and cuts with control.
- Pours own juice.
- Stands on one foot for five seconds.
- Throws a bean bag or ball, hitting a target.
- Handles self-care needs independently.

The Waupun Area School District, along with our community partners, offers the four-year-old kindergarten opportunity to all children who are residents of the district **and** who will be four years old on or before September 1, 2018. 4K is offered at three community sites and two school settings. Parents/guardians may choose a four-day or five-day program. Both types of programs receive the same quality education and meet or exceed state required hours for 4K with slightly different calendars. The collaborative partners work to create an environment which stimulates creativity and learning for children. We believe the community collaboration provides children and their families an array of learning opportunities that give children a jump-start in school and life.

All teachers have four-year college degrees in early childhood/ kindergarten and are highly qualified to work with preschool children. In addition, the teachers and assistants attend conferences and workshops about early education. The goal of Waupun Area School District's early childhood curriculum is to create an environment that promotes learning and social skills appropriate for four-year-olds. Children learn by doing... they use all of their senses to explore and get information. Play is the important work of a four-year old.

The Waupun Area School District 4K curriculum is aligned with Wisconsin's Early Learning Standards.
