### Board of Education Meeting Notes, July 11, 2022

#### Technology Update:

Vicki Lyons, Technology Consultant, reviewed a breakdown of the IT Dept. end-user groups including students, staff, families and the community. Information was shared concerning Infrastructure, Administrative Systems, Communications, Productivity/Academic Tools and Security. Additionally, Ms. Lyons discussed information requested by the Board including the IT Dept. service "ticketing" system (request for assistance), the process/timeline to complete requests, refreshing curricular resources, upgrading switches and future staffing for the IT Dept.

#### MOU: Late Start College Now Application:

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for a late Start College Now application was approved.

#### SCHS Co-Curricular Code:

Joel Wondra, Activities Director presented a proposal for the annual update to the district's cocurricular code. The proposed changes would allow for an adjustment to tardiness/attendance and academics. Discussion took place on academic ineligibility and possibly adjusting the code. WIAA does not require a specific standard, but does require that each district have a standard of their choosing in place. Mr. Wondra pointed out his proposed changes are meant to influence and encourage students to improve academically. The Board approved the recommendations.

#### Resignations/Retirements/Appointments:

There were no resignations, retirements or appointments to report.

#### Superintendent Anderson's Report:

Superintendent Anderson reported that the Shawano School District was selected to participate in a Department of Public Instruction (DPI) pilot project which provides broad band at no cost to up to 30 qualifying families in the district.
