## **Board of Education Meeting Notes, October 31, 2022**

#### Information Items:

We Need You Here Program Update: SRO Tyler Thornborrow updated the board on the We Need You Here campaign which addresses attendance. Officer Thornborrow discussed examples of positive student impacts and rewards including raffles, gift cards and treats provided by donations from local businesses. A quarterly letter was provided to the board and will also be going out to local businesses outlining program progress.

**Summer School Report:** Tom Dechant, Director of Pupil Services discussed last year's summer school program which was held at Hillcrest and SCMS. Hillcrest offered 15 different classes and had 150 students enrolled. SCMS offered 35 classes for 328 students. Shawano High School also held a credit recovery session for 312 students. Band and orchestra camps were also held.

#### **Action Items:**

**CESA 6 Evaluation Models:** Kurt Krizan, Interim Superintendent, introduced Wendy Dzurick, CESA Consultant, who presented a formal evaluation system for the board to consider implementing. Ms. Dzurick outlined the Central Office Performance Evaluation System (COPES) for district office staff and the District Administrator Performance Evaluation System (DAPES) for the Superintendent. The systematic approach to evaluation aligns with continuous improvement and includes goal setting, feedback, and reflection with documentation and artifacts. There are set-up and annual costs which were also provided to the Board. The Board approved adopting the evaluation system as presented.

Adoption of Final Budget for the 2022-2023 School Year: Denise Guex, presented changes to the budget based on increase in state aid, which lowers the tax levy from 7.2% to 6.86%. Other factors in final budget include open enrollment, special education and debt service. The Board adopted the amended budget as presented.

Certification of the 2022-2023 District Tax Levy: The Board approved the total tax levy of 6.86%.

**Start College Now Applications:** Kurt Krizan presented three Start College Now applications for College 101, English Comp., Data Base Development and Nursing Assistant courses. The Board approved the applications.

**Donations:** Kurt Krizan presented three donations for approval. \$680 in school store supplies for SCMS from Tumbleweed, Tom and Deb Boelter donated \$1000 for a coach bus to transport the Cross Country Teams to State Competition, and JR Machine donated \$250 for supplies to SCHS Rocketry Team. The Board approved accepting the donations.

- These Shining Lives theater production wrapped up over the weekend. Congratulations to cast and crew!
