## Board of Education Meeting Notes, February 6, 2023

**Superintendent Kurt Krizan's Shout Outs:** Featuring Shawano Community Middle School, 7th Grade Student Shout Out to Kian Morstad, Teacher Shout Out to Mr. Mike Homan, and 6th Grade PLC to: Brooke Huntington and Kristin Kamke. Congratulations to all!

**Information Items:** Jeana Winslow, Clerk, Board of Education, reported on the WASB Convention and highlighted topics such as trust from the board room to the classroom, financial oversight, safety planning and onboarding.

**Audit Report:** Leah Lasecki, Independent Auditor, CLA, reviewed an executive summary of the auditor's report, which is required by federal and state programs. The Board accepted the audit report.

**Achievement Gap Reduction:** Heidi White, Principal at Hillcrest & LEADS Primary reviewed mid-year progress toward end-of-year goals in ELA and Math and implementation of evidence based strategies.

Matt Peterson, Principal at Olga Brener Intermediate School, reviewed mid-year progress toward end-of-year goals in ELA and Math. He also discussed strategies including Tier 2 and 3 interventions, PLC examples and parent engagement. The Board voted to accept the report.

**Additional Elementary Professional Development Day:** Tom Dechant, Director of Pupil Services and Kurt Krizan proposed providing PBIS supports and re-training to teaching and support staff in grades 4K through 5, through the RTI Training Center. The training is provided at no cost to the district and would require an additional PD day for the staff. Proposal to add this time on Feb. 21 for 4K through grade 5 staff/support staff. There would be no school for 4K through grade 5 only, on the 21st. The Board approved the proposal.

**Policy Updates:** Jeana Winslow reported that the Policy and Curriculum committee met to review changes and edits to policies. The changes include maintaining the words "student" and "staff", the adoption of the NEOLA Bullying policy and pronoun corrections. Other updates would be addressed as they arise. The Board approved the updates to board/district policy.
