We are looking forward to another year of skiing and snowboarding at Brandywine Ski Resort. Consider joining us. **Beginners are welcome!** The Stanton Ski & Snowboard Club includes 5 lift tickets (4:00 – 8:00 pm; each Thursday from January 6 – February 3), rental equipment, and 5 lessons. **Note: there is no ski bus provided to Brandywine. Families must arrange their own transportation to and from the ski resort.**

Before we hit the slopes in January, parents/guardians need to **complete the NEW online registration and PAYMENT** of \$225.06. **This is a GREAT price for students who need rental equipment and lessons.**

Follow these easy steps for online registration and payment (due date is November 19):

2. Select either BRANDYWINE – SKI or BRANDYWINE – SNOWBOARD

3. On the next page under “SESSION,” choose THURSDAYS – 4PM

4. Click on the check box for “Include -5Week Lift AddOn”

5. Click “ADD TO CART.”

6. Click “CHECK OUT.”

7. Click “CHECK OUT AS GUEST.”

8. Type in the student’s name and birthdate then click “NEXT.”

9. Type in the student’s contact information and medical information then click the check box for “RELEASE OF LIABILITY” then click “ADDRESS AND PAYMENT.”

10. Complete the “Purchaser Information” and “Address Information” and “Payment Information” steps then click “CONTINUE.”

11. Review your terms and conditions, click the “Terms and Conditions of Sale and Privacy Policy” check box, and finally click “PURCHASE.”

IMPORTANT CHANGES IN SKI CLUB THIS YEAR:

1. THERE IS NO SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION TO THE SKI RESORT. STUDENTS AND FAMILIES MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM BRANDYWINE SKI RESORT DUE TO ARRIVAL CONFLICTS.

2. STUDENTS 12 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER MUST SHOW PROOF OF COVID-19 VACCINATIONS TO ACCESS THE BRANDYWINE SKI RESORT CAFETERIA AND SECOND FLOOR DINING AREA.

Kick off of Multi-week Ski Club Program

Boston Mills/Brandywine Ski Resorts are pleased to announce the kick off our 5-week ski club program for ages 8-18 at Boston Mills/Brandywine Ski Resort.

Please note that limited spots are available this year, and the deadline to sign up for Ski Club is November 19th.

Please note we have new safety protocols set in place for the 21/22 season. Guests ages 12 and over will be required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccinations to dine at our indoor, quick-service (cafeteria-style) restaurants. Guests will be required to show their Covid-19 vaccination card each time they enter our quick-service dining areas. You will not be able to enter certain areas of the lodge without a Covid-19 vaccination card. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen vaccination cards. If a guest loses their card, they must comply with our safety protocols. We are developing a plan for guests to come inside to warm-up. More information on where to warm-up in the lodge will be released closer to the season.

We are also requiring masks indoors for all guests.

We are fortunate that the core of the ski and ride experience takes place outdoors in vast mountain settings. However, as we welcome guests from around the world to the indoor experience at our resorts, we feel it is important to do our part to combat the spread of COVID-19. All of our policies are subject to change based on the evolving nature of the pandemic as well as federal, state, and local public health guidelines.

Lesson Details:

Lesson Start Date: WEEK OF 1/3/2022

Lessons are one-hour long

Advisors need to call-in to schedule arrival times, as lesson start times will be staggered and are subject to change.

Every Participant must have a valid Snow Pass/equipment for the session.

Lessons are held at Boston Mills/Brandywine. Every child must attend the same lesson each week. Makeup lessons are on a case-by-case basis, and are not provided unless BMBW must cancel the lesson.

FAQs:

Q: May I request a refund?

A: This is a no refunds program. In the event of an injury prior to or at the onset of the program, families may choose to submit their request, with medical documentation, to resort leadership. There will be no refunds due to illness and/or quarantine.

Q: Are helmets required?

A: Helmets are required for children 12 and under. Helmets are highly recommended for anyone 13 or over.

Q: What can we expect for safety guidelines around COVID?

A: Our commitment to safety is a priority at Vail Resorts. Navigating the COVID landscape is fluid. As such, please refer to our Winter Experience page for updated guidance.

Due to factors out of our control, the ski club has made some changes for this season:

*1. Stanton will NOT provide transportation to and from Brandywine Ski Resort due to arrival time conflict. **Students and families will be responsible for organizing their own transportation.***

2. As a COVID-19 protocol, Brandywine Ski Resort will not provide lockers for participants and will require proof of COVID-19 vaccinations to enter the 2nd floor cafeteria and dining area for those 12 years of age and over.
