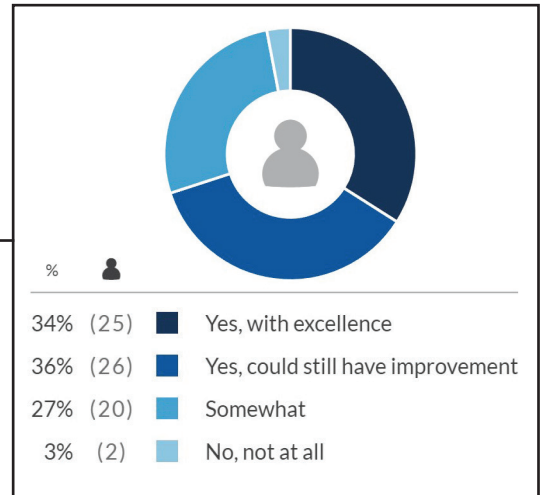

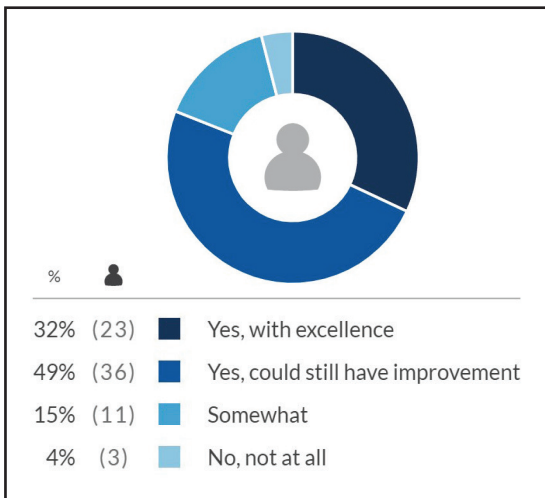
Are we clearly communicating and implementing health and safety protocols per state mandates?

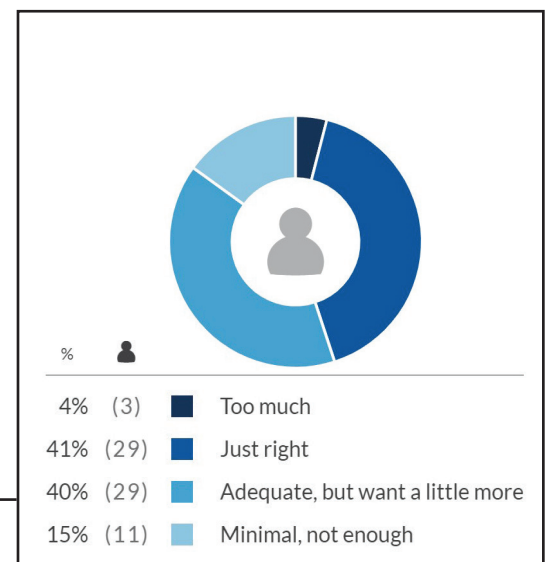
Students have been learning in-person 5 days a week for the past 8 weeks. Are we meeting the learning needs of Kelso students?

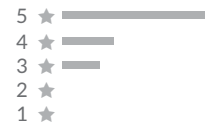
