FROM THE HEALTH OFFICES:

As we continue to navigate through the COVID-19 pandemic and transition towards the endemic phase, the SAU90 nurses would like to communicate this upcoming change related to contact-tracing. Following the recent state recommendations, contact-tracing is no longer required for those considered close contacts to someone who tests positive for COVID-19.

If a positive case is identified and is present at school 48 hours before they are diagnosed; a letter will be sent home (via email and /or paper) informing parents /caregivers that the student was a close contact /potential close contact. You would then be asked to self-monitor your child (for COVID symptoms) for the following 14 days.
