
## ReadyRosie:






**STEP TWO:** Enter Your First and Last Name

## Nurse's Update:



Jamie Waddell, RN, is the Lincoln County Early Childhood program-wide nurse. She will be at the Stanford Early Childhood Center daily, and she visits our other preschool classrooms for vision, hearing, and lead screenings. She will also be tracking vaccine records and gathering health information. If your child requires a special diet or health plan at school, Jamie will be in touch with you.

If any children are sick, they can visit the Nurse Practitioner via telehealth during the school day as needed. You may also choose to make an appointment at the board office clinic. Their number is 606-365-5783. The office is located behind the Board of Education in Stanford.

**Tuesday:** Together Tuesday "Student/Teacher Twin Day" - Students and teachers dress alike and share photos on social media #kyfamengage

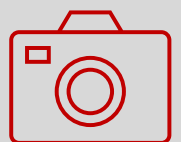
**Wednesday:** Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Share recipes unique to your childhood & culture - Cook as a family and share photos on social media #kyfamengage
