- Accomplishes maintenance tasks productively, independently and safely
- Plans tasks and organizes and performs those tasks while providing quality assurance to those tasks. Those areas include, but are not limited to:
  - Plumbing- Knowledge of repairing flush valves, piping leaks, relieving clogs
  - Electrical- Knowledge of replacing lamps, ballasts, various switches or breakers; basic electrical troubleshooting
  - Mechanical- Knowledge of and ability to replace and perform preventative maintenance on motors, bearings, filters, fans, HVAC systems
  - Painting- Knowledge and proper application of Interior/Exterior paint types and ability to apply on a multitude of surfaces using proper preparation and clean up techniques
  - Grounds Care- Ability to drive and perform safe operation of mowers (riding and walking), trimmers, weed spray equipment, pruning and planting; including safe operation of chainsaw, operation of various types of snow removal equipment
  - Hardware -Ability to repair/ replace door hardware (locksets, hinges, panic bars, door closers)
