


The Kittitas School District is seeking candidates for the District 1 Board of Directors' seat declared vacant at a regular board meeting held on August 16, 2023. The term of the board seat expires in concordance with the November 2025 election. Qualified candidates may apply directly with the Kittitas School District, or a member of the public may nominate them. Once the screening and interview process is complete, the successful candidate will fill the position immediately upon appointment by the Board of Directors.



Candidate Requirements:

The Board of Directors is seeking candidates interested in working together to provide a quality education for our students. Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- 1. the candidate must be a United States citizen,
- 2. must live in the State of Washington, and
- 3. must be a registered voter residing in District 1. Applicants should contact the County to verify their residence within the District 1 boundary lines prior to applying.

Application:

Candidates must submit the following information to the District Office located at 601 N. Pierce St., Kittitas, WA, no later than 4:00 p.m. on September 13, 2023:

- 1. Letter of interest,
- 2. Biographical overview, and
- 3. Statement outlining their reasons for serving as a Kittitas School District Board of Directors *Note: The District does not use an application form for this position.*
