**I. Call to Order by Board Chair**

**General Purpose School Fund:** The net increase in expenditures of \$64,500. This is funded by an increase in revenues (\$29,230) and a reduction in Fund Balance (\$35,270).

**Federal Projects Funds:** #936 (ESSER 3.0) – 2021-2024 total grant \$1,514,886.35.

**Café Fund:** No recommended budget amendment at this time.

A motion was made by David Queener to approve Budget Amendment Two, with a second by Curtis Isabell. The motion carried 5-0 (roll call vote).
