Events/activities at Madison School

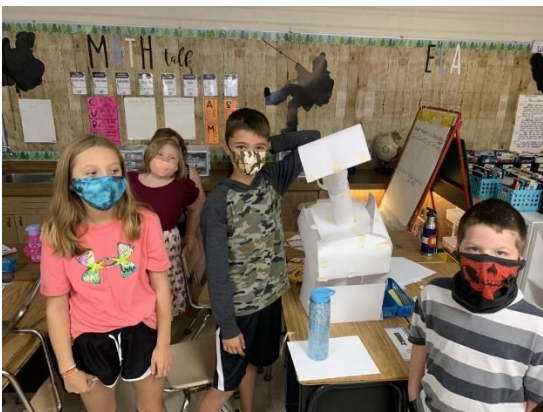
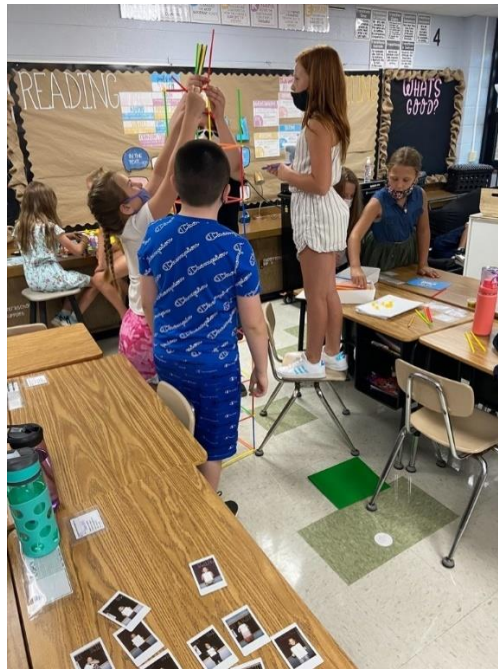
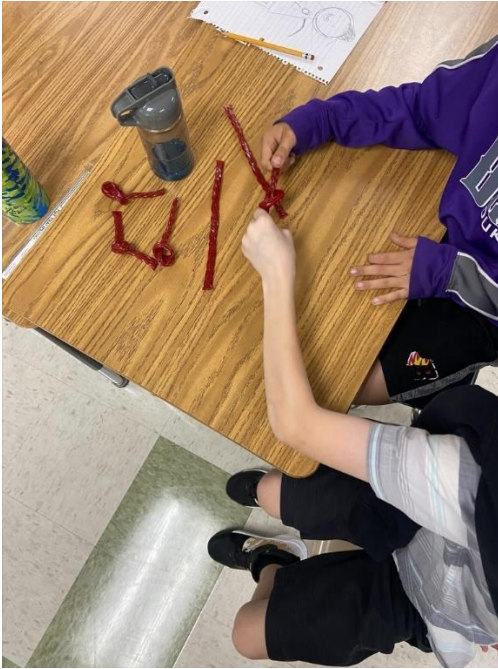
5th grade band tryouts coming soon!

Events/activities at Washington School

CLEAR Social Emotional Program:

Dr. Beth Cunningham is a Clinical Psychologist, from Florissa, that has been trained by CLEAR to provide Washington and Madison Schools a variety of Social Emotional supports throughout the school year and beyond. Dr. Cunningham provided staff with consult days on August 4th, August 26th, September 2nd, and will provide a day on September 23rd. These days are used to discuss various student issues with teachers and develop programming. Dr. Cunningham also provided professional development on August 13th. This ongoing student/staff training, and consultation, will continue in October.

STAR 360 Testing

Kindergarten and 1st Grade STAR 360 testing was completed on September 3rd. Title I Staff and teachers are currently administering 1:1 CBM testing to all students. Staff hopes to have most of those tests wrapped up by September 10th. Staff professional development to help better interpret this STAR 360 data will occur on September 22, 2021 during our School Improvement ½ Day.

ALICE Training

Washington's entire staff had ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, and Evacuate) training with Officer Lamandola and Officer Dempsey from the Dixon Police Department on August 13, 2021. The officers reviewed the previous ALICE plan and the plans for enhancements to the ALICE program.
